
How to Find your Login Name & Set your Password


You'll need your ctcLink ID (EMPLID) & ctcLink Password or SID & PIN, and a computer with internet & web browser. (Staff need to use another accessible computer, if your office computer needs you to log in.)

1. On the computer, **open a browser** (such as Chrome, FireFox, Safari or Internet Explorer)

<u>You will now go to the MySeattleColleges Login Tools Page</u> where you can find your login username and set a password for your first time use. **Setting a password initializes your MySeattleColleges account.**









- **4.** a. Enter your ctcLink ID (EMPLID) number in the ctcLink ID (EMPLID) box.
